

Summary report for the 19-20 December Meeting with the Advisory Board

1 Introductory Remarks

The 2016 Meeting is occurring almost in the end of 2016, at almost (but not quite) 2/3 of the current funding period. In 2017, IDL will need to submit a new strategic proposal for external evaluation. Although very few details are known of that process it is already apparent that the process will be designed from scratch, with at least 25 evaluation panels that will visit all groups, so we expect a more specialized panel (maybe in Geosciences) and a more robust evaluation.

Whatever details turn out to be decided for the external evaluation, IDL needs to present itself as a mature group, more compact and focused than was perceived in the previous exercise. The new structure with 5 Research Groups is a step in that direction. Another step is the progress made in some IDL central activities, namely in its web page, outreach initiatives, and PhD training program, which are now at a considerable better level than in 2014, and already working across all IDL fields. The third, and most important step, comes from a relevant evolution of the team by the attraction of promising young researchers, namely the 5 new FCT research contracts starting in January 2017.

Current IDL structure is largely the result of a renovation of the team, which started by the attraction of young post-doc researchers in the Ciência 2007/08 programs and in the IDL LA contract (2005-2014). A few of these researchers are now in permanent positions at the University of Lisbon, and play key roles in driving our research at different levels, most others have moved to other institutions often abroad. While IDL cannot control that process, as permanent positions are only offered by the University at the Department level, it is essential that new permanent positions can be regularly offered to the best of our researchers, progressively improving the scientific value of those departments.

In the preparation of the 2017 proposal we expect to fine tune the IDL structure. Unlike what was done in the 2014 proposal, where a drastic structural change was required, the new proposal will only improve our current structure. A review of the team will, however, be required, aiming to optimize research indicators and to reflect the real evolution of our research. Such changes will only be attempted once the rules are known in greater detail.

2 Highlights in 2015-2016

Each research group has prepared a short report, focused on its scientific achievements and objectives (key questions), supported by a list of deliverables in 2015-2016 (not complete in what concerns 2016). An integrated list of deliverables may be found at the end of the present document. As will be shown in the meeting, an analysis of those deliverables shows progress in bibliometric output, with an improvement in the number of papers, and in internal collaborations, while maintaining a high level of international co-authorships.

In 2016, the IDL outreach activities suffered a qualitative change, with the hiring of a new responsible for that area at the post-doc level. A specific report covers such activities, which

led, in particular, to the production of the IDL 2015 Highlights report, written for an external reader, completed in the summer 2016 and then sent to the advisory board. In spring 2017 a new IDL 2016 Highlights report will be prepared. Outreach activities now have a clear presence in the IDL webpage and Facebook, covering different audiences, from IDL members, to the research community, secondary school students and the general public.

The EARTHSYSTEMS Phd program, to be reviewed in February 2017 by its Advisory board, also showed important progress. The last call of the program, now under evaluation, had a record number of >120 candidates, improving from an average of 50-60 candidates in the 3 previous calls. In 2016, EARTHSYSTEMS organized its third summer school, now on (hands-on) "Solid" Earth numerical modelling, maintaining its yearly frequency. At the current cruise speed the program will peak in 2017 (with 32 funded students in different years). The future of these programs is currently unknown, but we believe EARTHSYSTEMS has been a very important and well managed program.

Some of IDL research was recognized in 2016 different contexts. Eric Font and Miguel Brito received the University of Lisbon prize. João Duarte was awarded the EGU Arnt Richter Award for Outstanding Young Scientists, to receive in EGU 2017.

Finally, IDL was very successful in the call for FCT research positions, receiving 5 new young researchers in 5-year contracts. It is worth stressing that two of these new contracts were already hired by IDL, confirming our hiring criteria. The three other come from abroad (Emanuel Dutra from ECMWF, Ricardo Ramalho from Bristol, Sónia Jerez from Barcelona). Altogether they represent a strong contribution to the IDL team.

3 Objectives

IDL needs to further consolidate as an Earth System Science group, taking benefit from its mix of researchers and students (under to post-graduate), from its research infrastructure and from its international networking. Such consolidation requires a continuous improvement of the team: attracting young researchers, offering them the best research and career environment, promoting synergy between researchers, and with other international teams. Some of this is, of course, controlled by available funding; but we must acknowledge that some of these key strategies are controlled by external bodies, such as the Departments. We need, however, to be pro-active in all these fronts.

Within the Portuguese Geoscience community, IDL is unique: it is a real group, not a collection of separate groups that apply to common funding; it has by far the largest student community, and the best laboratory, field instruments, and computing infrastructure; it is already able to run relevant common programs associated with advanced training and outreach; it has excellent administrative support. This ability to pursue common interests at the IDL level has allowed us in the past to concentrate resources on the hiring of researchers, and in key infrastructures.

In the near future we see an opportunity to further increase intra-IDL synergies, building from the experience of the EARTHSYSTEMS program. Even if funding for the PhD program from FCT is interrupted, we should maintain it, as a way to increase interactions across IDL research fields. The possibility of synergies with the Sustainable Energy Systems program, where IDL collaborates with groups in 3 other schools and with MIT, should also be explored

IDL also needs to respond actively to the new funding opportunities, at the national and international levels. At the national level, the priority has been set by FCT to implement the new research contracts, which replace post-doc grants, and IDL will try to have a competitive profile in those calls. At the international level, we expect that the group evolution will allow, for the first time, some competitive proposals at the highest level, namely for the ERC calls. At the same time, IDL researchers will certainly keep an active role in different FCT and European project calls.

4 The 19-20 December meeting

IDL meetings with the Advisory Board have always played an important role in the establishment of IDL strategy. Considering the yet undecided rules for the next external evaluation exercise, which do not allow for some important decisions that will have to be taken in the near future, we have decided to ask each group to write a scientifically focused report addressing its recent achievements and the key scientific questions that the group sees driving its next research. We have asked all groups to look at last year's report from the advisory board, when writing its report. At this stage, we didn't try to reassess the global scientific strategy, as the 3 research lines prepared for 2015-2020 maintain its full relevance.

We are looking forward to the next meeting for an open and fruitful discussion with the Advisory Board. We will try to show that we have made significant progress, but, as usual, we expect an independent critical view of our work, which can help us progress further.
